### Who can apply?

- o **High School Seniors (Scholarship Applicants Only):** College-bound high school seniors of African descent
- o **College Students:** Continuing college students of African descent

All scholarship application materials must be submitted electronically on the 2020 Links Scholarship Application Form by Sunday, March 1, 2020, 11:59 p.m.

- o Click on 2020 Links Scholarship Application Form. Fill in your name and scroll to the bottom to click on ***"I am a high school senior or college student, and I want to apply for the Links scholarship."***
- o Follow the instructions on the form (including a 400-500 word essay entitled, "Why I Think I Should Receive the Madison Metropolitan Chapter of The Links, Incorporated Scholarship")

- Official Copy of High School Transcript **OR**
- Official Copy of Academic Institution Transcript (if you are already in college)
- Copy of SAT or ACT Score Report

- Two Letters of Recommendation (letters from relatives are not acceptable)
- Filled out and SIGNED Parent Permission Photo/Biographical Data Release Form
